



Middle School:

In-Person Audition Requirements

SDSCPA is welcoming middle school students who have a passion for the arts and are interested and committed to focused training in their area of interest at SDSCPA. Training is not required to be accepted into SDSCPA.

Things to expect on the audition day:

Please arrive on time and be prepared to participate!

- Wear comfortable clothing and appropriate shoes. You may bring a bottle of water.
- If you are auditioning in dance, wear form-fitted athletic or dance attire. Please secure hair from your face and neck, so that we can see your movement and you can move safely.
- No additional materials are required.

At the Audition

You will participate in a workshop-style audition and will be given opportunities to showcase your artistic passion in a collaborative setting.

No additional materials are required.

Workshops will take place over a 2-hour period. All students will remain for the entire duration of the audition workshop.

Students will be evaluated individually. Areas of assessment will include:

- Craftsmanship
- Personal Expression

All SDSCPA Auditions are closed.

Parents/Guardians are not able to view the audition or accompany their student to the audition room.

Those waiting will have an opportunity to participate in classes for parents and guardians, including School Choice, Admissions and Enrollment Questions, School Tours, and Panels with current CPMA Middle School Students.
