In-Person Audition Requirements

The Music Department is looking for middle school students with passion for Music. Students will demonstrate their musical skills, perform a solo with their intended instrument, and tell us about their passion.

To apply to the SDSCPA Middle School Music program:

Please come prepared with your instrument and audition sheet music. A music stand will be available for your use.

If you are singing and need to plug in a device, please let the person monitoring your room know prior to entry. Please have your music cued and ready.

1. Please introduce yourself. Include:
 1. Your first and last name
 2. The grade you will be entering in the Fall
 3. What instrument(s) you play
(If you are auditioning for Vocal Arts, you can mention your vocal range – Soprano, Alto, Tenor, Bass, etc., if you know this information.)

2. You may be asked the following questions in your audition:
 1. What do you enjoy about playing (or singing) music?
 2. Why do you want to come to SDSCPA?

3. Play a musical selection on your instrument, or sing a song!
Remember to introduce the musical selection you will be performing.

Haven't received a musical instrument yet?

No problem! Our audition team has special audition exercises to assess the passion of students still at the beginnings of their artistic journey.

All SDSCPA Auditions are closed.

Parents/Guardians are not able to view the audition or accompany their student to the audition room.

Students will be evaluated individually. Areas of assessment will include:

- Creativity
- Passion
