In-Person Audition Requirements

The Dance Department is welcoming middle school students who have a passion for dance, and are interested and committed to focused dance training in Ballet and Modern at SDSCPA. Formal dance training in Ballet and Modern is not required to be accepted into the SDSCPA Dance Program.

To apply to the SDSCPA Middle School Dance program:

Things to expect on the audition day:

1. Please arrive on the day of your audition wearing form-fitted athletic or dance attire. Please secure hair off of your face and neck, so that we can see your movement and you can move safely.
2. You may be asked the following questions:
 - What is your first and last name?
 - What is your age?
 - What grade will you be entering in the Fall?
 - Why do you want to attend SDSCPA?
 - What do you love about dance?
 - Have you ever taken dance before? If so, what types and for how long?
3. You will participate in a Ballet and Modern Dance class led by SDSCPA Faculty.

All SDSCPA Auditions are closed.

Parents/Guardians are not able to view the audition or accompany their student to the audition room.

Students will be evaluated individually. Areas of assessment will include:

- Craftsmanship
- Personal Expression
