## To apply to the SDSCPA Middle School Creative Writing Department:

Come prepared to share your passion for reading and writing stories!

### **In your audition, you may be asked to:**

1. Introduce yourself. Include:
  1. Your first and last name
  2. The grade you will be entering in the Fall
  
2. You may be asked some of the following questions:
  1. Why are you interested in attending SDSCPA?
  2. Why do you want to be a Creative Writing Major?
  3. Why do you love reading and writing?
  
3. Bring some samples of your writing!

Have you written a story you really like? Do you have a script or a poem you are really proud of? Do you write lyrics to songs? Do you have a report for school you worked hard on? We would love to see it!
  
4. Write while you are in the audition. (Unscored Activity)

You will write a short piece in your audition. This will be a prompt that may include words and/or a picture. You do not need to use the prompt in your writing - it is there just to help you get started in your thinking. Have fun, be creative and use your imagination!
