The applicant shares a desire to work at in a professional manner and shares who they are in their work.
	3 -	Applicant demonstrates basic skills and techniques, and a willingness to learn. Takes direction and makes an effort towards improvement with feedback. Demonstrates as desire to share themselves in the work and pursue the craft of Acting with passion.
	2 -	Applicant shows a general interest and understanding of basic skills and techniques. Has difficulty processing direction and feedback, with little to no improvement shown. Can discuss general information about their artform when asked, but does not instigate conversation.
	1 -	Applicant shows no interest or understanding in their artform, and shows an unwillingness to learn. Does not follow or contribute to conversations. Reflects no passion or interest in their craft.
